We have had an exceptionally busy half term. The children have been learning about volcanoes and other natural disasters, materials and their properties in science, and have created their own animations in computing.

In our maths lessons, the children became detectives for the week. Using their maths skills, the children had to solve clues in order to track down a vicious criminal.



The children have been learning all about different natural disasters this half term. They have learnt about tectonic plates and how the tectonic plates can result in volcanic eruptions and earthquakes.

We looked at how a volcano explodes and demonstrated this with a very interesting – yet sticky – demonstration with a lemonade bottle!



In English lessons, the children have been reading some of the Grimm Tales. During lessons, the children wrote their own version of a story, trying to imitate author Philip Pullman.

In computing lessons, the children worked in groups, taking one of the stories and turning it into an animation. The children storyboarded their film, created sets and backdrops and then animated their characters. We used the music of Howard Shore and John Williams to score our films.
