Another half term has passed and it has flown by. The children have worked incredibly hard and have produced some fantastic work over the last few weeks.

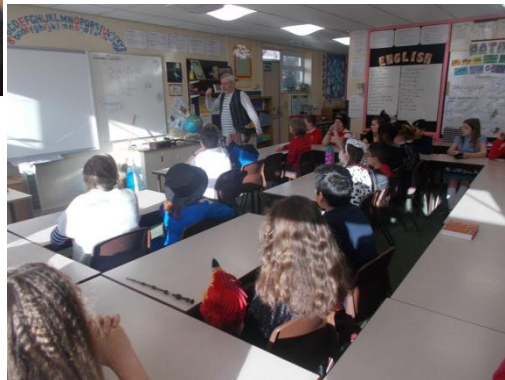
