Sticky Knowledge

Parents/Carers can help children by discussing these essential facts and skills with their children.

Science

- Identify and name a variety of common animals.
- Identify animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores
- Notice animals have offspring which grow into adults.

Geography

- Know the names of the four countries that make up the UK.
- Know the name of and locate the four capital cities of England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.
- Know which is N, E, S and W on a compass.

History

- Talk about the past and present using appropriate vocabulary.
- Ask historical questions and use information to help answer them.
- Describe people, objects and events through writing, diagrams, models and timelines.
- Use a wide variety of sources to find out about the past.
