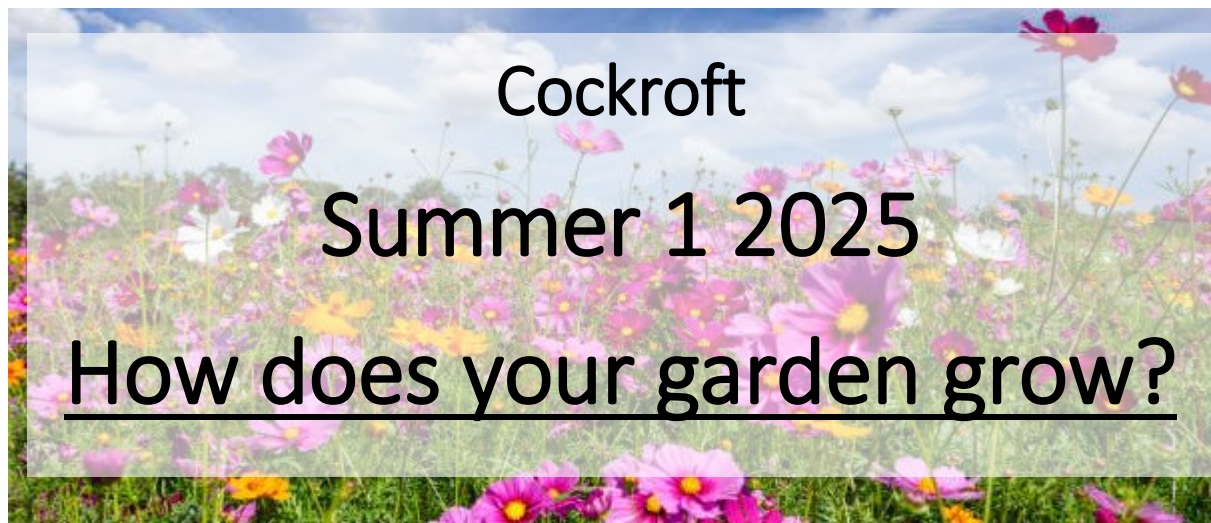




Intent

Sticky Knowledge

Parents/Carers can help children by discussing these essential facts and skills with their children.

Science

- Know and name a variety of common wild and garden plants
- Know and name the petals, stem, leaves and root of a plant

Geography

- Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom.
- Know which is the hottest and coldest season in the UK.
- To identify the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles.

PSHE

- Know that money comes from different sources and can be used for different purposes, including the concepts of spending and saving
- Learn about the role money plays in their lives including how to keep it safe, choices about spending or saving money and what influences those choices .
